

# FRUIT TREES – 2011

## APPLES - Grafted on dwarf root stock M9.

**James Gieves** – Partially self-fertile. Dual variety apple (Dessert and Cooking). Yellow flushed red. Harvest: September.

**Spartan** – Self-fertile. Dessert apple with characteristic colour. Flowers resistant to spring frost. Disease resistant and suitable for the small garden. Harvest: October-November.

**Sunset** – Self-fertile. The Cox alternative with more flavour. Harvest: October.

## CHERRIES - Grafted on dwarf Colt root stock.

**Stella** – Self-fertile. Dessert cherry. Harvest: July.

**Sunburst** – Self-fertile. Black sweet cherry. Harvest: July.

## PEAR - Grafted on the dwarfest root stock – Quince C.

**Concorde** – partially self-fertile. Great reliability and flavour. Harvest: September

## PLUMS - Grafted on Pixie root stock which is not strictly dwarf but easily manageable.

**Czar** – Self-fertile. A reliable early purple-black culinary plum of upright hardy growth. Harvest: August - September

**Imperial Gage** – Self-fertile. Reliable and hardy with high yield of yellow fruit. Harvest: August - September

**Merryweather** - Self-fertile. Damson. Producing a high yield of large black fruit for bottling, jams or dessert. Harvest: August - September.

**Victoria** – Self-fertile. Dual variety. Large bright red fruit. Prolific and reliable. Fruits: August-September.
