Looking Good – Edibles

29.5.20

All our edibles are grown in organic, peat-free compost.

Fruit Bushes

Gooseberries 3 litre pots - £8.00

- 'Hinnonmaki Red'
- Self-fertile.
- Berries start off pale green and mature to a deep burgundy red colour from mid to late July.
- When pinkish they are excellent for cooking and when fully ripe they can be eaten from the bush.
- Height & Spread: 1.6m (5ft).
- Juvenile thorns on the bush at the beginning but disappear with maturity.

Tayberries – cross between raspberry and blackberry

3 litre pots - £6.00

- Requires plenty of space! 2.5 – 4m.
- Needs full sun to produce a good crop.

- Fruit forms on one-year old canes so those that grew last year will fruit this year.
- Train any new canes upwards or tie them to one side to keep them separate.
- In autumn, cut out all the old canes that have borne fruit and retrain the new ones into place in preparation for the following year.
- Pick berries on a dry day when they are ripe, plump and juicy in July to mid-August.

Strawberries

'Elsanta' 1l - £3.00

- Orange-red fruit with delicious taste.
- Harvest: June to July
- Best in a sunny site and well-drained soil
- Spread straw around the plants to protect the fruit

'Fresca' 9cm - £2.50

- Large dark red fruits from end of June.
- Vigorous compact plants are almost runnerless
- Good for hanging baskets and containers
- Feed regularly with liquid feed
- Sheltered sunny site

Redcurrants 3 litre pots - £8.00

• **'Rovada'**

- Large, luscious fruit produced in profusion on huge 'strings'.
- Height & Spread: 1 – 1.5m.
- Approx. 2.7kg of fruit per plant.
- Harvest: July – August.
- Excellent eaten fresh or from the freezer.
- Full sun or partial shade and well-drained soil.

Brassicas - A wide range of leafy vegetables like cabbage, brussels sprouts, broccoli, kale and cauliflower.

Cabbage

- **'Stonehead'** - Early ball head type. Round medium green heads. Good bolting resistance. Harvest: June – September. 6 pack - £3.00
- **'Red Drumhead'** - Red Cabbage. Solid round heads. A compact variety suitable for the small plot. Harvest: June – September. 6 pack - £3.00

Cauliflower

- 'Minaret' – Romanesco variety **6 pack - £3.00**

Brussels Sprouts

- 'Bedford Darkmar 21' - Pick from bottom of stem and work upwards. Harvest: mid-August – early April. **6 pack - £3.00**

Calabrese / Summer Broccoli

- 'Marathon' - Produces small, evenly sized buds with good bud colour. Deep well formed heads. Tolerant to downy mildew. Matures after 75 – 95 days. **6 pack - £3.00**

Purple Sprouting Broccoli **6 pack - £3.00**

Beets – Beetroot, Spinach, Chard

Beetroot

- 'Boltardy' – **Globe variety**. Smooth skin with deep red flesh. **6 pack - £3.00**

Beet leaf

- **Perpetual Spinach** – Similar to spinach, but the leaves are larger, darker and fleshier. **6 pack - £3.00**

Legumes - beans and peas

Runner Beans

- 'Painted Lady' - Red and white bi-coloured flowers. Produces short, tender and flavoursome pods. Harvest: July – October. **3 pots - £2.50**
- 'Hestia' - Dwarf bi-coloured variety that look great in a containers. Good quality beans over a long period. **3 pots - £2.50**

Climbing Dwarf French Beans

- 'Fasold' – Long, round stringless pods with black seeds. Quick to mature. Superb flavour. Harvest: July – October. **3 pots - £2.50**

Squashes - Summer type: Courgettes and Marrows.

Courgettes

- 'Green Bush' – Bush variety. Striped fruits. Pick as standard sized courgettes or leave to mature into marrows. **9cm - £3.00**

- **'Shooting Star'** – Climbing yellow courgette with an upright climbing habit. Can be grown in a smaller garden and pots. Grow against a framework and tie the stems in regularly to help support the weight of the fruits. 9cm - £3.00

Pumpkin

- **'Racer'** – Semi-bush variety producing fruits typically 4-7kg in size. Good colour – ideal Hallowe'en pumpkin. 9cm - £3.00

Butternut Squash

- **'Waldo'** – Fruits typically 1.2 – 1.8kg in size with a distinctive nutty, butternut flavour. 9cm - £3.00

Cucumber

- **'Pepinex'** – Smooth long, dark green, thin skinned, smooth cucumbers, which have slight ribs, great taste and are bitter free. 9cm - £3.00

Sweet Corn

- **'Lark'** – Grow in a block for wind pollination. Cobs typically 20 – 21cm in length, 18 rows of grains per cob. Bright, golden kernels with exceptional and consistent eating qualities. 6 pack - £3.00

Lettuce - All are 'cut and come again' varieties. This year we are selling them in a mixture of the different varieties. **'Matador', Isira and Cancan.** 6 pack - £3.00

Hot Pepper

- **Cayenne Red** – Hot, pungent pepper with long, thin fruits maturing from green to red. 9cm - £3.00
- **Apache** – Dwarf, chilli pepper producing good yields on compact plants. 9cm - £3.00
- **Demon Red** – Ideal for growing in containers and can be used both as an ornamental and edible pepper. The flowers and outward pointing fruits are produced throughout the season and turn from green to deep red with maturity. 9cm - £3.00

Fruit Trees

Unfortunately we cannot deliver fruit trees. They would have to be collected from the nursery gate.

All Fruit trees in 20 litre pots - £30.00

APPLES - Grafted on dwarf root stock MM106

Semi-vigorous rootstock grown as a half standard. Can be trained as a fan or espalier.

Height: 3.5m / 11ft.
